*POTENTATES MESSAGE:*



Our March Stated Meeting was well attended at the temple and three zoom locations. Lots of business was discussed, with the future of the building being one of the most important. After good points being brought up, both for and against selling the building, a vote was taken. The required 2/3 majority was reached to start the process of selling the building. A realtor will be contacted, and the details will be discussed at our June 5, Stated Meeting. We will continue to occupy and maintain the building until it is sold. We have to replace the 100-gallon water heater for \$1,700, which supplies the kitchen, as it is leaking. We will put some gravel in the holes in the parking lot as a temporary remedy, cost unknown.

As we move forward, membership is second only to providing services to our Shrine patients. Declining membership has us at about half the membership we had when we bought the building and less than one-quarter of what it was twenty years ago. At the rate we are going, Imperial projects us to be less than 400 by 2025. When that happens, we will lose another voting representative at Imperial Session. We just returned from the CSSA business session where Imperial Chief Rabban Bill Baily asked, "Who is on your temple membership committee?" After several answers, someone gave him the answer he was looking for, "Every member of the temple." I know last year was a tough one to get anything done, but Past Imperial Potentate Jeff Sowder's "Just One" membership drive needs to continue. It is the only way to ensure our temple will survive in the future to provide the children who need Shriners' care the services they need!

We did reveal some extraordinary good news that is coming our way. A woman named Betty J. Huffman from Beloit left her estate to the Solomon Valley Community Foundation. She never married, and her father was a Shriner. She directed that 2/3rds of the income be directed to Isis Shriners to be received in a 501(c)3, which can only be used for patient travel and donations to the hospitals. We will expect to receive the first payment in 2022 of approximately \$40,000 and annual amounts after that. The temple is in the process of establishing the Isis Shriners Benefit Fund as a 501(c)3 tax-exempt entity. Any additional donations to this fund will be tax-deductible. The temple itself is a 501(c)10 fraternal organization, to which donations are not tax-deductible.



The Divan will be working to put together the plan to sell the building and move when the sale is complete. This information will be discussed and voted on by the Nobility on June 5, 2021, at the Stated Meeting. This vote is essential because the Nobility must have a say in moving forward. We plan to have a wonderful dinner, a fantastic program, and some pretty cool entertainment that evening after the meeting, so I hope to see you during the meeting and that you stay for all of the festivities that follow. There will be more information about this event as it gets closer.

There are still over 90 Nobles who have not paid their dues for 2021. If they were to pay, it would generate over \$9,000 worth of revenue. A list of these Nobles will be emailed out in the near future. If you receive this list, please give it a look, and if you know one of them or live in the area as one of them, please reach out to see if they had plans to pay them in the near future. Try to remind them of the great work we do as Shriners and the fantastic medical work that Shriners Hospitals for Children can provide to the children.

Even though the Nobility voted not to sponsor the circus this year, this event will still take place. Tarzan Zerbini and Tony's Pizza Events Center will be working together to bring the ISIS Shrine Circus to Salina, KS. The dates for this event will be April 30 (one show), May 1 (3 shows), and May 2 (one show). The official times will be sent out when they are released. The ISIS Shrine will be allowed to sell coloring books to raffle off the 6' Shrine Teddy Bear and \$50.00 during intermission of each show. We are also being allowed to sell Sportsman Event tickets, 50/50 tickets, and other raffle tickets. The ISIS Shrine is in need of 12-15 volunteers to help sell these items during the shows. If you are interested, please let me know and I will get your name on the list. The Divan member point of contact for that day will be Treasurer Gary Kay. No past tickets will be honored during this show. *Tickets will have to be purchased through Tony's Pizza Events Center in order to attend the circus.*

And then walk away feeling like it was the best conversation you've ever had.


It's true that we don't know

It probably hurts the other person, too.




## ***/\$100K/\$150K/\$200K CLUB***



P.P. III Sir Mark Smith (2018) started a program during his year as Potentate where Nobles, Ladies, Units, Clubs, or anyone, could make an obligation to donate \$100 a year for 3 years. When they made this obligation, they were recognized with a lapel pin and a certificate showing their membership. This program brought in much revenue for the Temple to use. Since the 100K Club was such a success, the ISIS Shrine Divan has decided to expand to 150K and 200K Club's.

The ability to become a member of these Club's are as follows:

100K-\$100 a year over 3 years, or all at once (\$300). Once the first payment is received, a pin and certificate are presented.

150K-\$150 a year over 3 years, or all at once. (\$450) After the last payment is received, a pin and certificate will be presented.

200K-\$200 a year over 3 years, or all at once. (\$600) After the last payment is received, a pin and certificate will be presented.

\*If someone wants to join all 3 levels at once, they can pay \$1300 and save \$50.

\*If present 100K members want to join the 150K and 200K all at once, they can pay \$1000 upfront and save \$50.

# Shriner's Hospitals for Children-St. Louis Information

## Spine care

The medical team at Shriners Hospitals for Children — St. Louis treats spine conditions of all degrees – from a fatigue fracture in the lower spine that requires careful monitoring to congenital kyphosis. They respond to the individual needs of each patient and work to achieve the best possible outcomes through advanced surgical care, therapy and research.

More about spine conditions we treat:

## Neck

**Torticollis** is a rotational deformity of the cervical spine which causes turning, head tilting and deformity of the head. It is also known as “wryneck.” Conservative treatment involves manipulating and stretching, cervical traction or collar, and medications that prevent pain and spasticity. In some cases, surgical intervention is needed to release soft tissue structures or clipping of accessory nerves and some nerve roots.

**Tethered spinal cord** is a neurological disorder caused by tissue attachments that limit the movement of the spinal cord in the spinal column. This condition is often seen in conjunction with [spina bifida](#). Treatment for this condition is surgery.

## Spine

**Kyphosis** is an abnormally rounded back. Treatment may include physical therapy. Surgery may be necessary for a severe curve or if the spinal cord is being pinched.

**Lordosis** is an exaggerated swayed back. Treatment may include physical therapy or bracing. Surgery may be necessary for severe cases.

**Scheuermann’s disease** is a more severe form of kyphosis, or abnormal rounding of the back. Treatment may include physical therapy or bracing. Surgery may be necessary for a severe curve or if the spinal cord is being pinched.

**Scoliosis** is a progressive condition causing the spine to curve. Treatment may include bracing with custom orthoses made in-house. Surgery or [halo-gravity traction](#) may be necessary for severe cases.

**Spondylosis** is a defect or crack in the back part of the vertebra, which causes back pain. Spondylosis can occur in the cervical (neck) or lumbar (low back) spine areas. Treatment for spondylosis may include medication, steroid injections, physical therapy or bracing. Surgery may be necessary to prevent further slipping.

**Spondylolisthesis** is the slipping forward of a vertebra over a lower segment, which causes back pain. Treatment for spondylolisthesis may include medication, steroid injections, physical therapy or bracing. Surgery may be necessary to prevent further slipping.

Other changes are less paid staff, and the evaluation involving keeping a physical home for the Temple. February saw the income decline sharply from 2020 as did the expenses. For the year to date, we are nearly <\$6,000> behind a breakeven budget. The three largest expenses for February was Building operations, Office operations and Hospital Transportation fund expenses.

Our challenge is to stay focused on the mission of the Shrine,"for the kids". With this focus and the cooperative efforts of our glorious band of Nobles, progress can and will be achieved.
