POTENTATES MESSAGE:

Starting the new Temple year, I would first like to thank Illustrious Sir Darrell Ryan and his Lady Valerie, for all they did to keep our Temple going in 2020. I don't have to tell you what a difficult year it was with events postponed or cancelled. Despite this, we had a very successful Sportsman's Event in October, netting the Temple just over \$15,000 after expenses! With the 2020 Potentate's Ball cancelled, I have invited Illustrious Sir Darrell and Valerie to co-host the 2021 Potentate's Ball on May 29 in Hays and they have accepted. Their theme was "Titanic" and ours is a "Beach Party," so maybe we'll end up with the Titanic on a beach!

The 2021 Potentate's Fund raiser is a 50/50 raffle with tickets being sold all year and the prize drawn for at the December 4 Christmas Party. On Sunday, January 17, I visited the Northwest Kansas Shrine Club in Goodland and the club purchased \$1,000 of tickets to get it started! A huge thank you the Nobles who voted unanimously to support our Temple! Recorder Casey has tickets at the temple and will mail books of 25 to any Noble who can help us sell them. This has the potential to be our largest fundraiser this year. Can you join in selling tickets?

This spring we are also once again selling Vidalia sweet onions. We had a new farm last year and the onions we received were the best I had seen in many years. He is our supplier again this year. The order form is in the newsletter. An idea I have used where I live is to make an order sheet with columns for name, address, phone#, 5# bags, 10# bags and check number or cash if paid. I stick this to a large envelope and leave it on the counter in the beauty shop and many of the patrons will order that way. I have not had a shop turn me down. I plan on helping distribute onions; if you sell them, I'll bring them to your club!

We had not had a stated meeting since August with all the restrictions Salina placed on gatherings until January. At the August meeting, the Nobility voted to look at a plan to sell our building in Salina and alternative plans for an office and meetings. The office spaces available in Salina run from \$500-\$1,000 per month plus utilities. We can make a move within the City of Salina without having to have a petition signed and submitted to Imperial before proceeding. If the Nobility votes to move the Temple out of Salina, then a petition signed by 90 members must be submitted to the Temple for a vote. In either case, the new location has to be designated before submitting the request to Imperial. Our ability to carry out these plans hinges on if we can sell the building for a decent price so we have the capital to establish elsewhere. If we move first we will have to continue maintaining the current building until it is sold. This will create a financial burden with no known time frame. We will be discussing this further at the next stated meeting in March and if the Nobility brings the question to the floor, we will have a vote. We are at the point where we have to decide if we are an organization that focuses more on managing a piece of real estate or serving the children who need our help getting to Shriners Hospitals.

POTENTATE MESSAGE CONTINUED

Another important issue that was discussed and voted on at the January meeting was the status of our circus this year. It costs over \$60,000 to bring the circus to town, advertise, buy novelties and other incidentals. With Covid-19 causing many schools to disallow field trips and concerns for the health of our Nobility and ladies working at the circus, the Nobility voted to cancel this year's circus. We cannot hold an event that has the potential to lose tens of thousands of dollars.

On a positive note, our Spring Ceremonial is still planned to be in Scott City with the pre-glow and perhaps a Turtle Degree on Friday, April 30 and the Ceremonial on Saturday, May 1. The Scott City Shrine club always does an outstanding job putting on the Ceremonial! We need to create more new Shriners to maintain our numbers. Do you know a Master Mason who will make another great Noble among us?

I am looking forward to this year, built on the successes we've had in the past. We all need to be positive about our future caring for children and having as much fun as we can doing it. What can you do to help your Temple?

Many have articles throughout this newsletter. There is a section within the newsletter that introduces them to the Nobility. 2021 is going to be a great year!!!

On January 16, 2021, there was a Stated/Annual Meeting and the ISIS Shrine Divan election. Three remote locations joined the meetings via Zoom. Thank you to Scott Lundgren for managing the Scott City area, Charlie Baker for managing the Goodland area, and Thomas Jackson for managing the Manhattan area. There were a total of 50 Nobles present at all four locations. There were many different items discussed during the meeting. BJ Harris, Kansas Shrine Bowl Director, gave a presentation about last year's game and this upcoming game on June 26 in Hutchinson, KS. There was a discussion about the ISIS Shrine Temple location. The last big piece of information discussed was about the 2021 circus. After much discussion, Noble Greg King made a motion not to have the 2021 circus, and the motion was seconded. After further discussion took place, a vote was taken and passed unanimously. I know that many Nobles had purchased tickets last year to be used for this year's circus. If you would like a refund for these tickets, please mail the tickets with a letter requesting a refund to the office, ISIS Shrine, P.O. Box 2778, Salina, KS, 67402. The tickets and letter will need to be received before the ISIS Shrine will issue a refund. I hope that the Nobility will not request a refund and instead will consider their purchase a donation. The ISIS Shrine will also mail a letter to all Nobles with this information and much more information.

With the circus canceled, there are three fundraisers scheduled at this time. They are the Potentate fundraiser (information located in the newsletter), Vidalia onion sells, and our annual Sportsman event. There is an order form within this newsletter for Vidalia onions, and you can download it from our website (www.isisshriners.com). Once you have made all of your onion sales, please submit just one order to the office with the total amount of onions you sold, as well as the money. The office does not need to know who you sold to or how much you sold to them. Once we know the delivery date, usually late April early May, we will contact the sellers to pick up their orders to be delivered. The Divan will be putting together the Sportsman event plans soon and getting tickets mailed to the Nobility. Sending this information to the Nobility this early in the year will give them plenty of time to purchase/sell tickets to make this event even more successful than in the past years.

At the time of this letter, there were still 184 Nobles who had not paid their 2021 dues. If you have not paid your dues, please do so at your earliest convenience. These funds are what helps keep the Temple operating on a day to day basis. If these 184 Nobles paid their dues, it would bring in \$19,145 in operating revenue. If you are not sure if you have paid your dues or not, you can log into WebFez (www.webfez.shrinenet.org), and you can see what you owe and even pay. You can also call the office, and I will also be able to help find that information. If you have paid your dues but have not received your 2021 sticker, there is a delay in mailing from Tampa, FL. They ask you to give them 6-8 weeks after paying your dues before expecting to receive your 2021 sticker. The office has not received any, so we cannot issue them to anyone.

Due to COVID-19, many things within the printed calendar have already changed. You can find the changes in the back of this newsletter. I also encourage everyone to visit our website and look at the calendar that we keep up to date weekly. I suggest that if you plan to attend a Unit/Club meeting, you reach out to their officers to ensure they are meeting.

Starting in February, there will be new officer operating hours. The office will be opened Tuesday through Friday, 9:00 AM through 5:00 PM. I still encourage Nobles to call the office (785-825-0206) and set an appointment if they need assistance. There are meetings and other errands throughout the day, as well as the office doors remaining open. If you need help after hours, please email me at issshinerecorder@gmail.com.

I want to close this month's Recorder Corner by thanking every Noble and Lady of the ISIS Shrine. Because of you, we can be successful at taking care of the children throughout our 43-county jurisdiction. Please remember that the children and their healthcare are why we are Shriners. Working together is the only way we can be as successful as we are. I ask that we continue this excellent working relationship amongst ourselves. Other organizations have internal strife that has caused them not to be as successful or have completed folded organizations. 
Praying at the beginning of the New Year does not bring immediate change at the stroke of midnight, but it does begin the opening of our hearts to God's Words of hope and peace.





If it does show up in your spam folder, you should be able to right click on it and mark it as not spam. This should then allow it to start being delivered to your regular inbox folder. This email option is also how the newsletter is sent to Nobles and Ladies.
