The Potentate's 50/50 Raffle fundraiser is off to a great start! So far, clubs from Goodland and Scott city have both purchased \$1,000 worth of tickets, making the prize over \$1,000 so far. This will be drawn for at the Christmas Party December 4th. Tickets are available from the temple.

The next stated meeting is March 27 at 4:00 p.m. in the temple. This is a **very** important meeting at which proposals for **the future of our building** will be discussed and voted on. Moolah Temple in St. Louis has done this for several years and it has worked well for them, so I "borrowed" the idea. There will be a total of 50 prizes this year. Dear Brothers, Sisters, Family and Friends,

I hope this finds all of you healthy and enjoying life. It is a little sad to see the first of this year is continuing down the same path as last year. Although almost all other events were cancelled for the month of January and February, we did get the chance to hold elections. The first part of February, several of the Shrine Bowl players were presented with their certificate and plans are still underway to have the Grid Iron dinner in Russell on the 28th of February.

It has been a long year, but things are looking up. If things continue, March 5th will see the installation of the Legion of Honor officers. This will be followed up with TGIF on the 26th and a Stated meeting on the 27th. This does not include many of the Shrine Club meetings or the Blue Lodge meetings. So, things are looking up along with the weather tempter, we hope.

It is disappointing that we could not have a circus this year. The decision was not an easy one and the Divan had to weigh a lot of different aspects. In the end, there were three things that we focused on. The first is the health and safety of the ISIS members that would be asked to help, along with the health and safety of those that would attend the event. Second was the overwhelming possibility that we would not turn a profit. None of us has a crystal ball to tell the future, but we all agreed that we could not risk a financial loss at this time. The third and final thing is that we felt we have several other events that we can focus on this year.

One of those events is the Sportsman Raffle. Preparations are progressing very well and plans are underway to get tickets mailed to the nobles in the next couple of months. Another event is the 50/50 raffle. There have already been over 200 tickets sold. We really hope that everyone will get out and sell them. This could be a fantastic fund raiser this year. Not to mention that the winner stands the chance to win a really nice size pot of gold.

Several years ago, a fund raiser was started called the 100K club. It was an agreement by any individual to commitment to give \$100 per year for three years. This year we have expanded this and now have a \$150K and \$200K club. The agreement is still the same, a \$150 and/or \$200 commitment per year for three years. There is a little incentive, if anyone wants to pay the upfront cost of \$1300, it will complete the commitment with a savings of \$50. For those that have already completed the \$100K club, if you choose to pay the upfront cost of \$1000, it will complete your commitment with a savings of \$50. Please get the word out about this. This is not just for Shriners, anyone can participate. If you have questions or want to join, please let me know.

These are just a few of the many exciting things happening this year. Keep checking the calendar as things are still changing day to day. We are doing our best to hold as many events as possible. Please, as I have said before, dust off that fez and be a part. Help make this year a fantastic year.

When opening the door he underwent an amazing transformation.. His face was wreathed in smiles and he hugged his two small children and gave his wife a kiss.


Afterward he walked me to the car. We passed the tree and my curiosity got the better of me. I asked him about what I had seen him do earlier.

FINANCIAL COMMITTEE REPORT

Greeting Nobles!

I am writing this prior to the Valentine's weekend and the major cold weather event of perhaps many decades. As a Noble member of the Financial committee I have been asked to submit a brief report of the ongoing finances of the ISIS Temple on a monthly basis. Several decades ago, I attended a wrestling camp led by Olympic Champion Shelby Wilson. His overriding message was K.I.S.S; "keep it simple, stupid". Later in life, I learned "keep it short & sweet". If I perhaps make it too short to fully explain something, please let me know and I will make it right.

The 2021 year started with some of the normal transactions. Total income was \$71,223.87, of which, \$60,000 was the annual transfer of prepaid or early paid dues. Dues for the current period totaled \$6,271.00. The balance of the income was from Donations and Other Income.

The expense side was the transfer of \$ 60,000 into the general fund. \$7,408.88 went to office, administrative and operation expenses. The end result was an overall loss for the month of <\$905.79>. This is a major improvement over the 2020 month of January which was over <\$3,000> short.

We have a long journey ahead and the year is yet young. With the increased transparency, and enhanced communication, I feel we can all pull together in an unified effort to improve our Temple's ability to be there for the Kids! I welcome any and all suggestion to improve this monthly report.




