336.2 Public Exhibitions and Civic Parades.

(a) **Shriners Only.** Notwithstanding the provisions in §335.11, in parades of temples at annual Sessions of Shriners International, unless written dispensation is received from the Imperial Potentate for the annual Session during his term in office, or in local Shriners parades or exhibitions under the auspices of temples or Shrine associations, only Nobles shall participate.

Amend. 2017

(b) **Civic Parades.** In civic parades, and non-Shrine public appearances, Nobles, their ladies and children, and Masonic-related or sponsored organizations, may participate, with the approval of the Potentate. Only Nobles may perform, compete, ride vehicles with fewer than four wheels, or operate any vehicle while parading. I believe this means we can invite our Lodges and Eastern Star organizations to parade with us to raise their image in our communities and get some cooperation going between us.



WHAT IS THE FEZTIVAL OF TREES?
