Each ticket entitles the bearer to attend the party and have a barbeque Brisket & Ribs meal prepared with the Potentate's illustrious recipe. We will also have Past First Lady Connie Ingle's Cowboy Beans! And there will be more....

Fall Ceremonial is going to be November 6 at the Temple with the Pre-Glow Friday night the 5th. Building membership is the key to our future survival and ability to continue serving the patients who so dearly need us. The new petition is in this newsletter; print off as many as you need! Can you bring in some Brothers to join our cause?

At our Stated Meeting we had reports of all the Summer activities and discussed what's ahead. The Circus was discussed and the cost has increased for Tony's Pizza Event Center and we have been unable to get a bid from Tarzan Zerbini for the show. Citing the still present Covid virus, several Western Kansas School districts are not going to allow field trips if their students are exposed to large groups from different areas. After a lengthy discussion, a motion was made to cancel the circus for 2022, due to these uncertainties which might make the event lose money. We are still open to holding a circus in future years if it looks profitable. In the meantime, we need to come up with other fundraising ideas to keep us afloat!

If you pay by credit card, the Temple does get charged a fee, so can you consider making an additional donation of \$5-10 to help offset this cost? Thank you in advance for doing this!

POTENTATE MESSAGE CONTINUED

The Isis Shriners Benefit Fund is now in place as a registered 501(c)3 with the IRS. This means that donations to it are tax deductible and the fund can only use this money for patient services, hospital donations and education of the public about Shriners Children's services. As a retired Financial Advisor, I know this will allow individuals to leave a portion of their tax-deferred investments to the benefit fund. This would include IRAs, 401(k)s, annuities and similar investments. The benefit fund will pay no income tax on such distributions, where an individual would have those amounts added to their taxable income. You should always consult your tax advisor and your wife before making the benefit fund a designated beneficiary. Can you give this some thought?

Our Recorder, Casey Flinn, has done an outstanding job of planning our Christmas party at the Hilton Garden Inn in Salina. I approved a request to move our stated meeting and elections in December to the same day, December 11. It should be a great day to be a Shriner! The meeting is at the Temple as required starting at 1:00 p.m. and the Christmas party will start at the hotel at 5:30. For \$30 per person, you get hors d'oeuvres, 2 drinks, steak or chicken for dinner, dessert and TWO National Patient Ambassadors sharing their experience. Can you beat a deal like that?

MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF RABBAN

This month the Divan along with members of the Nobles Finance Committee spent many hours going over projected revenue and expenses for 2022. Afterward, four tentative budgets were prepared for presentation at the September stated meeting. Two things happened that eliminated two of the budgets.

1. We learned that commercial real estate was not selling very well due to continued COVID concerns. So far we have had no offers. Based on this it was voted to delay any further action on our building until at least January of 2022.
2. Again, based on COVID concerns and the possible impact on our budget it was voted to not have the circus in 2022.

This left two possible outcomes for our 2022 finances.

1. With no circus and if/when our building sells we will have a SMALL surplus.
2. With no circus and we do not sell the building we will have a LARGE hole in the budget.

I do believe that doing something about the worst-case scenario will ensure that we can continue our mission of supporting kids who need our help. So far this year and just thru the Salina office, we are supporting 21 patients with 58 visits costing approximately \$24,000.00. I know several Shrine Clubs also support kids on their own and that is deeply appreciated.

So what do **WE** do?

The Divan, Shrine Clubs, and Units must devise fundraisers that not only raise awareness of what we do but also why people should give of their time & money to provide medical care to kids who need our special kind of care. Take a few minutes when you're selling Sportsman tickets, onions, 50/50, or other raffles to tell a story about kids we've helped. If you don't know anyone personally, read the stories of our National Ambassadors.

To encourage onion sales next year every Club and Unit will get back 10% of their sales. This is being done to offset revenue those groups will have lost from Isis not having a circus. This fundraiser is in March and April but we need something to start the New Year. We need your suggestions for not only what your club can do but also how you'll support each other.






SHRINER LEGACY PROGRAM

WHAT IS THE FEZTIVAL OF TREES?

The FEZtival of Trees is a family-friendly Christmas Tree Decoration Extravaganza held by Isis Shriner Ladies which brings together families, neighbors, businesses and community partners to celebrate the many joys of Christmas, while holding true to the generous spirit of the holidays themselves.

Local businesses, organizations, Shrine Clubs, and families donate fully decorated artificial Christmas trees which are displayed and raffled off to the public. Tree winners will receive their very own uniquely decorated Christmas tree PLUS all the gifts contained on or under the tree.

The name of the event comes from the iconic red hats worn by Shriners.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Fully Decorated Trees and Gifts are donated by local businesses, organizations, Shrine Clubs, or families
2. Tree Extravaganza (open to the public) – spectators enjoy viewing the uniquely decorated trees
3. Each tree has a theme and prizes on or under it that go along with the theme
4. Each Tree will have a Ticket Box – spectators purchase raffle tickets and place them in the box for the tree they wish to win

When they made this obligation, they were recognized with a lapel pin and a certificate showing their membership. This program brought in much needed revenue for the Temple. Since the 100K Club was such a success, the ISIS Shrine Divan has decided to expand this program to 150K and 200K Club's. The ability to become a member of any of these Club's are:

100K-Commitment of \$100 a year over 3 years, or all at once (\$300). After the last payment is received, a pin and certificate will be presented.

150K-After completion of 100K, a commitment of \$150 a year over 3 years, or all at once (\$450). After the last payment is received, a pin and certificate will be presented.

200K-After completion of 150K, a commitment of \$200 a year over 3 years, or all at once. (\$600) After the last payment is received, a pin and certificate will be presented.


