RECORDER'S CORNER CONTINUED

There are still many Nobles who have not paid their dues for 2022. At the time of this publication, we still had 73 Nobles who owed for 2022. If all of these Noble paid in full, it would generate around \$8,905 in revenue. This list is being worked on by the office and will be sent out to Nobles asking for their assistance in making the list shrink. Thank you in advance to all who can assist.

At the end of March, I emailed all Unit and Club leaders asking for a donation to the Temple to help increase our funds in the travel fund. We have had a significant gift left to the Temple, but we cannot access it until September 2022. This donation is needed, so please discuss this at your next Unit or Club meeting. I also asked for a donation to help repair the garage doors on the Uniformed Units building. It has sustained wind damage with repairs of just over \$8,300. Unfortunately, our deductible for wind and hail damage is \$10,000, so turning the claim into insurance cannot happen. Please discuss this request at your next Unit and Club meeting. The support from Units and Clubs has always been highly appreciated, so thank you in advance to those who can make these donations.

Along with my Lady Megan, I want to thank you for your continued dedication to the Isis Shrine, Shriners International, and Shriners Children's. If there is anything I can help you, your Club, or your Unit with, please do not hesitate to reach out, and I will do my best. Remember, no man stands so tall as when he stoops to help a child!!! In many ways, we are like the buzzard, the bat, and the bumblebee. We struggle about with all our problems and frustrations, never realizing that all we have to do is look up!


That's the answer, the escape route and the solution to any problem...just look up!



2022 PARADE GUIDELINES

Per Shriner International Protocol (2019), please remember that no candy or other objects shall be HANDED OR THROWN from any vehicle in the parade. A Shriner might walk along the edge of a parade route and hand out Shrine information or other appropriate objects. Nobles shall not drink any alcohol beverages before or during any parade, and they shall be circumspect in the use of soft drinks in public places so as not to give the impression they are drinking alcoholic beverages. Shriners International has adopted the fez as the exclusive type of head covering to be worn by all nobles when appearing as such. This means all nobles must wear their fezzes at stated meetings, ceremonials, Shrine parades, caravans, special Shrine events, and any other Shrine-related activities.
