You will leave weak



So, why so much hatred, resentment, envy, selfishness and pride?



2022 PARADE GUIDELINES

Per Shriner International Protocol (2019), please remember that no candy or other objects shall be HANDED OR THROWN from any vehicle in the parade. A Shriner might walk along the edge of a parade route and hand out Shrine information or other appropriate objects. Nobles shall not drink any alcohol beverages before or during any parade, and they shall be circumspect in the use of soft drinks in public places so as not to give the impression they are drinking alcoholic beverages. Shriners International has adopted the fez as the exclusive type of head covering to be worn by all nobles when appearing as such. This means all nobles must wear their fezzes at stated meetings, ceremonials, Shrine parades, caravans, special Shrine events, and any other Shrine-related activities. If any noble would like a copy of this protocol, please contact the office and it can be emailed to you.
