

THE WISDOM OF SOLOMON

When God approached Solomon in a dream and offered to grant him anything he wished, the response from Salomon was remarkable.

Then God said to him: Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice. 1 Kings 3:11

In the Bible verse above, we find an example of the wisdom of Solomon and his deep connection with God, which speaks to the core of our desires and priorities as Believers.

Solomon did not ask for riches, power, or fame; instead, he requested discernment and wisdom to administer justice.

For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; Proverbs 2:6


