Spring Ceremonial is rapidly approaching, and it would be great to have a large group become nobles in Goodland April 27th. Make plans to join the fun.

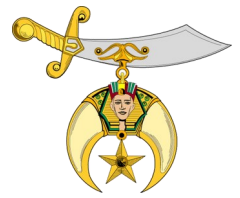
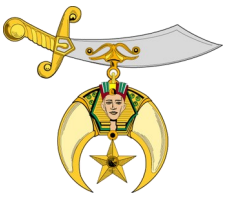

Nobles and Ladies,



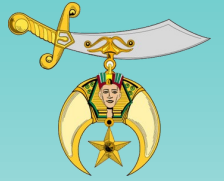
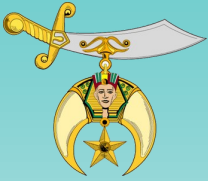
