Already coming into September, the Isis Shrine continues to stay active in all of its communities by parading and conducting fundraisers. There are still many Nobles who still owe dues for their 2024 dues. This list is later in the newsletter. If you know someone on this list, please reach out to them and encourage them to pay their dues ASAP. If they do not pay their 2024 dues by December 31, 2024, they will be suspended for non-payment of dues. This is per Shriners International bylaw §323.9(a)(2). I encourage Unit and Club leadership to look over the list and see if they might be able to provide financial relief for some of the Nobles by paying their dues for them if the Noble is not able to. The 2025 dues have already been posted, and in September, Nobles will start to receive dues notices via email. If possible, please pay them online. You can find this link by going to our website and clicking on the "Pay Dues Here" button. If you do this, it saves the Imperial from sending out due notices via regular mail and, in return, saves the Temple money on postage and printing. If a Noble has not paid their 2024 dues, then both their 2024 and 2025 dues total will display when they pay online, and they will have to pay both in full. Be advised that the production of yearly stickers is going to stop. Your dues card will still be good, and your membership will be able to be checked by using the QR code on the back of the card.

At the beginning of September, all Nobles will receive a letter with many inserts pertaining to the Stated Meeting on September 21, 2024, Club and Unit leadership elections, and the Stated Meeting and election of Divan members on December 7, 2024. Please pay close attention to this letter, as it outlines directives from Shriners International, and some other important dates and events that will take place over the next couple of months.
