

- 2. All payments must be due in cash/check. Checks can either be written out to Juanita and then she will write one check to our agency or the checks can be written out to First National Travel Agency.
- 3. Package price is based on 30 travelers. If we have less than 30 sign up, we will need to reconfigure the price.
- Final payment will need to be submitted by July 2, 2025 (60 days prior to departure) at which time it becomes nonrefundable.
