

CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

THE GIFT OF FORGIVENESS

This will be last article as Chaplain. I hope you all have enjoyed my messages over the years.

The great gifts of this season, or any season, cannot be put under the tree; you cannot wear them or eat them or drive them or play with them. We spend so much time on the actual gifts we put under the Christmas tree, and we forget to spend the time on the gifts God has given us, like understanding, grace, peace, and for-giveness.

"Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins." (Acts 5:31)

Do you have unforgiveness in your life? Is it making your life miserable? Will you let Jesus show you how to forgive those people who have hurt you? One of the gifts that the Holy Spirit empowers us to do is forgive. To some of us, that sounds like an impossible task that even God would not ask us to do. Some of the people we do not want to forgive really did hurt us. Forgiveness is the main reason that Jesus was born and has offered to each one of us.

We were all sinners who fall short of God's glory, and without the blood of Jesus, we lived a life of misery, because separated from God, our lives are hopeless. Jesus offers us forgiveness of sins and a relationship with God.

- 3. Package price is based on 30 travelers. If we have less than 30 sign up, we will need to reconfigure the price.
- Final payment will need to be submitted by July 2, 2025 (60 days prior to departure) at which time it becomes nonrefundable.
