#### **2024 Dues Delinquents**

There are still over 30 Nobles who have not paid their 2024 dues. Not paying their dues means that they are not allowed to vote at Club, Unit, or Temple meetings, and cannot participate in parades, or other events. This is because they are not covered by our insurance if their dues are not paid in full. If these Nobles paid their dues, over \$4,000 in revenue would be generated for the Temple.
