Itinerary:

September 2-Depart Salina early morning. Drive to Davenport, Iowa via 56 passenger coach. Check in to Doubletree by Hilton Davenport. Hotel is situated in downtown Davenport near restaurants and attractions. Hotel restaurant on site.

September 3- Tour the Mississippi River Visitors Center, Visit Rock Island Arsenal Museum, Wine tasting at Wide River Winery, and a few hours at Isle Casino Hotel in Bettendorf.

- 4. Final payment will need to be submitted by July 2, 2025 (60 days prior to departure) at which time it becomes nonrefundable.

2025 Dues Delinquents

There are still 118 Nobles who have not paid their 2025 dues. Not paying their dues means that they are not allowed to vote at Club, Unit, or Temple meetings, and cannot participate in parades, or other events. This is because they are not covered by our insurance if their dues are not paid in full. If these Nobles paid their dues, over \$17,000 in revenue would be generated for the Temple. If you are one of these Nobles, or know one of these Nobles, please take care of this at your earliest convenience.



Membership Status Options:

Temple Lifetime Member

If a Noble would like to become a lifetime member of the Temple, they will pay 20 times the annual dues if they are 65 years of age or younger and ten times the annual dues if they are 66 years of age or older; after that, he is exempt from the yearly Temple dues.

Life Per Capita Member

If a Noble would like to become a Life Per Capita Member, they will pay 30 times the current per capita tax; after that, he is exempt from the annual per capita tax.

Hospital Permanent Contributing Membership

If a Noble would like to become a Hospital Permanent Contributing Member, they will pay \$150; after that, he is exempt from the annual hospital levy.

<u>Combination of Lifetime Memberships</u>

A Noble can join any of the above lifetime categories at any time. He can pick one, two, or all.

Donation Program Options:

Hospital Directly

Money can be donated directly to any Shriners Hospitals for Children of their choice. Our Temple can collect and send it on their behalf, or a donator can send it independently. This donation is tax deductible for whoever is donating.

Children's Hospital Travel Fund

Money can be donated to this account, which helps pay for travel expenses for the patient and one parent. This helps alleviate the pressure of trying to budget travel expenses. It covers flights, gas, hotels, and food. This donation is tax deductible for whoever is donating.

Building Maintenance Fund

Money can be donated to this account, and it is put back for when repairs to the building are needed. This helps to ensure that the building is kept up and operational. This donation is not tax deductible.

General Fund Donation

Donations to this fund will be used for the daily operation of the Temple. The fund covers many expenses generated throughout the year. This donation is not tax deductible.

\$100 Million Club

This is a one-time donation to Shriners Children's endowment. When the payment is made, you are then authorized to wear the \$100 Million tassel holder on you fez. You will also receive a certificate for your donation.
